Integrated support for acquired brain injury



Many people with acquired brain injury (ABI) suffer from weaknesses in making plans, tracking time, keeping tabs on multiple projects, initiating tasks, completing tasks on time, remembering details of conversations and recalling sequential or non-sequential steps or lists.

Characteristically, people with ABI use combinations of techniques to try to gain some semblance of control over their lives. Often, this ends up being a barrage of notebooks, alarms, sticky notes, folders, lists, calendars, personal digital assistants, cell phones, reliance on family members - multiple, disparate pieces with plenty of room for breakdown and error leading to stress both for the person with ABI and their family.

AbleLink Endeavour is an integrated, discreet, and portable solution for managing time, sequential and non-sequential tasks, lists, notes, instructions, phone calls, and more.

Based on a Windows™ Mobile PDA or phone, Endeavour uses an intuitive and simple **Dashboard** where users can record and play back verbal To-Do lists, be notified of voicemails and missed calls and see the next scheduled event. They can also access Endeavour's full range of functions with a single tap on the screen

Audio Visual Scheduler

The powerful scheduler manages calendar events whether the event is recurring or only requires a one time reminder.

The reminders can be audio and reinforced with a picture.

A timer can be set to give a reminder after a period of time.

Past and future events can be reviewed with ease



Task Prompter

Play back verbal prompts to give step by step instructions to help sequence tasks.

Generate task sequences without having to use a PC



Visual Mobile Phone

A simple mobile phone provides a pictorial prompt for people in the address book.

Missed calls and voicemails are easy to handle through the Endeavour Dashboard.

Callers are identified by name and picture



Digital Audio Recorder

The audio recorder allows up to 4 hours of recording at a time.

It is invaluable as meetings or other events such as a Doctor's appointment or rehab session can be played back later for review
